Free School Meals and Pupil Premium

The school is aware that with the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) programme automatically providing all children up to Year 2 with a free meal every day, many families do not apply for means-tested free school meal provision until their child reaches Year 3. This could mean parents are missing out on other sources of support they are entitled to, linked to household income and the benefits of associated pupil premium funding. It can very quickly lead to the victim feeling trapped, scared and vulnerable to grooming and blackmail.




Online safety is when young people know who they can tell if they feel upset by something that has happened online.
