
Homework Survey for St Andrew's Parents and Carers Summer 2024

Heart for the Earth filming

Over the past year, the children have been engaging with the Diocese of St Albans' *Heart for the Earth* initiative. We have been exploring across school life how we might use our 'heads, hearts and hands' to bring about a more sustainable future where people and planet can thrive.

This term, we will be visited by the resource creators and a professional filming company. The purpose of their visit is to hear more about how we have used the resources as a school and the difference they have made to the school community's thinking and actions regarding environmental issues, including climate change.

Pupil Premium/Free School Meals - Reception, Y1 and Y2

The school is aware that with the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) programme automatically providing all children up to Year 2 with a free meal every day, many families do not apply for means-tested free school meal provision until their child reaches Year 3. This **could mean parents are missing out on other sources of support they are entitled to**, linked to household income and the benefits of associated pupil premium funding.
