School Meal Price Increase

In line with other local primary schools, the price of a Hertfordshire Catering child school meal will be increasing to £3.50 from 1st April 2025. Please note this price rise is one week before the Easter holidays.

Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

The school is aware that with the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) programme automatically providing all children up to the end of Year 2 with a free meal every day, many families do not apply for means-tested free school meal provision until their child reaches Year 3. This could mean parents are missing out on other sources of support they are entitled to, linked to household income and the benefits of associated pupil premium funding.

When your child reaches year 3 school meals become chargeable.



What is a Free School Meal? A KS2 school meal costs £3.35 per day. Multiply this by 190 (days in a school year) and **Free School Meals are worth £636.50 a year!**
