## **Uniform Reminder**

### **KS1 and Reception**

- white polo shirt, woollen jumper or cardigan (with or without logo)
- grey trousers, short or skirt/pinafore
- grey or white socks
- black shoes
- Summer - white and blue checked dress may be worn
- PE kit - light blue T-shirt (with or without logo), blue or black shorts or skirts and trainers. A blue, black or grey tracksuit may be worn in colder months
- blue or black hair ties
- no jewellery is preferred - small stud earrings and/or a small cross on a chain may be worn under consideration of loss or injury.

### **KS2**

- white shirt, school tie, woollen jumper or cardigan (with or without logo)
- grey trousers, shorts or skirt/pinafore
- grey or white socks
- black shoes
- Summer - white and blue checked dress may be worn
- PE kit - light blue T-shirt (with or without logo), blue or black shorts or skirts and trainers. A blue, black or grey tracksuit may be worn in colder months
- blue or black hair ties
- no jewellery is preferred - small stud earrings and/or a small cross on a chain may be worn under consideration of loss or injury.

School uniform plays a key role in promoting pride, self-confidence, and a feeling of belonging within the school. These factors contribute to children's wellbeing, removing the additional pressures of deciding what to wear and added stress of meeting the expectations of their peers.

Every effort has been made to minimise the cost of our school uniform and the vast majority can be bought from local supermarkets. We have a small number of book bags (£8) and ties (£5) in school that can be purchased from the office (cash only).
