Please be aware that the deadline for applications to secondary schools is fast approaching. All parents and carers need to make an application online or on paper by the closing date of **Tuesday 31st October 2023**. But HCC would recommend that you complete the application by Friday 27th October, so that if there are any queries, they can be dealt with by the Admissions Team ahead of the deadline.

School lunches

School lunches are provided free of charge for children in Reception and KS1. For children in KS2 lunches cost £3.20 per day and payment is online via the School Gateway. Please can we remind parents that lunches must be paid for in advance (**pay as you go**) and your account may be frozen if it is in arrears. Thank you.

Free School Meals

The school is aware that with the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) programme automatically providing all children up to Year 2 with a free meal every day, many families do not apply for means-tested free school meal provision until their child reaches Year 3. This could mean parents are missing out on other sources of support they are entitled to, linked to household income and the benefits of associated pupil premium funding. 
