Cross Country Run

On Tuesday 14th October, Mrs Small, Mrs Daniell and Mr Dean travelled with 32 children to Leventhorpe to take part in their KS2 Cross Country Competition. Four other schools took part in the event.

There were eight races in total with Year 3 and 4 children being asked to run a kilometre and Y5 and 6 running 1500m around the fields of Leventhorpe School. Each competitor's finishing place contributed to a team score to give an overall year group winning school. As is typical of St Andrew's children, everyone gave their absolute all to their races which included individual victories and top 10 places for many of our pupils.

- Y4 Girls 2nd Y4 Boys 3rd
- Y5 Girls 3rd Y5 Boys 4th
- Y6 Girls 1st Y6 Boys 3rd

We were immensely proud of the children's encouragement of one another (we were by far the loudest cheerleaders for our team!), and their sporting attitude toward other schools.

A huge thank you to our parents who transported the children to and from the event, without whom, we would not have been able to participate, and to our staff who looked after the children whilst there.

There will be lots of further opportunities for children across school to participate in sporting events as the school year progresses.

Road Safety in Early Years



This week as part of our road safety topic, Jackie, our lovely Crossing Patrol, came in to speak to Nursery and Reception children about crossing the road. She talked about Super Cat and Super Cat's Road Safety Rap.

The children were reminded that they always need to hold on to their adult's hand when close to the road and when they are ready to cross, they need to stop, look both ways, listen and think 'Is it safe to cross?' and when Jackie says it is OK, we can cross. Please support your child with Super Cat's message when crossing our busy road.

In addition, this October/November is HCC are running a 'Stop Means Stop' campaign aimed at drivers:

STOP MEANS STOP

If you are fortunate enough to have a School Crossing Patrol at your school, you may notice they are wearing a bright orange 'STOP MEANS STOP' tabard this October/November.

The 'STOP MEANS STOP' campaign is run to remind drivers how important it is to stop for a patrol, helping to keep you safe every time you cross the road.



If you are driving and your School Crossing Patrol requests that you stop, please do stop and remember they are there to keep your children safe and do a great job, turning out in all weathers.



The patrol stands central in the road until everyone is safely on the other side, so please wait until they leave the road and are safely back on the footpath before driving away. This may seem like ages but in fact it is usually less than a minute.

Now the clocks have changed

the mornings and afternoons are darker. Using the patrol is the safest place to cross, as they can be seen from a distance in their bright coats and hats.

Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

The school is aware that with the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) programme automatically providing all children up to the end of Year 2 with a free meal every day, many families do not apply for means-tested free school meal provision until their child reaches Year 3. This could mean parents are missing out on other sources of support they are entitled to, linked to household income and the benefits of associated pupil premium funding.

When your child reaches year 3 school meals become chargeable.



What is a Free School Meal? A KS2 school meal costs £3.50 per day. Multiply this by 190 (days in a school year) and Free School Meals are worth £665 a year!






