<p>Barriers to learning faced by pupils in receipt of the Pupil Premium grant at our school include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • social/emotional barriers at some point of their school career • economic barriers faced by parents/carers at some point of their school career • children who are, or have been, a child looked after • 5 out of 20 of our pupil premium children also have an identified Special Educational Need • 3 out of 20 of our pupil premium children are considered to be more able than their non-pupil premium peers in either Maths, English or both • 11 out of 20 of our pupil premium children are working towards the expected standard in either Maths, English or both <p>Some of our Pupil Premium children no longer have free school meals, or their parents/carers financial situation may have improved. However, the impact of past difficulties is sometimes still evident in their school work or emotional development. It is important that these children are given the opportunity to fully achieve their potential.</p>
