RE

Our focus religions this term are Sikhism and Christianity. The two questions we will be considering this term are:

Summer 1: How do Sikhs put their beliefs about equality into practice?

Summer 2: Why do Christians believe they are people on a mission?



Art and DT



Our focus in the first half term is DT, which will be linked to our Science learning. The children will evaluate a range of torches and then design a functional torch for a target audience. We will then move onto our Art unit 'Sculpture and 3D: mega materials!' This unit will support children to take their drawings from 2D to 3D and use different materials to create structures.

PE

PE is again on Wednesdays and Fridays each week. Please ensure that children come to school in their PE kits on those days. This half term we will be focusing on tennis and games that promote collaboration/team work. During the second half of the term, we will be developing our skills in athletics and also have a dance unit. Lessons will be outside where possible and appropriate, so please do make sure that clothing is appropriate for all weathers.



Computing

Over the coming term, we will follow the units effective searching, hardware investigators, and writing for different audiences. Effective searching will allow children to use search engines more efficiently while hardware investigators will give them the knowledge to name and describe parts of a computer and their functions. Writing for different audiences will develop children's understanding of how ICT is used in the wider world.

Music

Our new specialist music teacher, Mrs. Marshall, will continue to work with the children each week across the school. The children will continue to develop their skills in composition and performance.

Our units following the JIGSAW scheme of work this term are relationships and changing me.
